



Vacancy Multimedia Assistant for *New Welsh Review*

We are recruiting for a temporary post to produce audio and video features on books and literature in conjunction with our publishing assistant

The magazine's successful formula of coupling one person with a Creative Writing or Literary Studies background with another with a film and audio background, to work on producing book-related video and audio pieces, continues into its third year as recruitment opens for our paid winter placement.

This placement is for one month only, starting 11 January 2016 and ending 5 February 2016. The successful candidate will produce, together with our publishing assistant, audio and video features including creative videos based on contemporary poetry, audio reviews and an author interview video. We expect to recruit from the pool of third year students and postgrads with experience of film-making, audio recording and film editing. The post should appeal to ambitious individuals who wish to join the book/journalism/broadcasting industry. You will work as a close team to real-time deadlines with professional supervision and create concrete work samples to improve employability and garner references. Application deadline: midnight Wednesday 25 November, 2015 (provisional interview date, Tuesday 8 December). Work produced will go live in a multi-format edition of *New Welsh Review* in March.
